If it chooses Option 2, PhilGEPS Reg. certificate will be part of the post-qual docs. Since the bid opening is scheduled on 08 June, the deadline for the submission of post-qual docs is on 15 June (Monday) assuming that ASI is the LCB. So, the bidder has more than 15 days to secure its updated PhilGEPS Reg cert.</p>
