C. JUSTIFICATION AND BENEFITS

C.1 JUSTIFICATION

On 16 March 2020, an Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) and the Stringent Social Distancing Measures were implemented over the entire Luzon from 17 March 2020 to 13 April 2020. On 7 April 2020 the ECQ was extend until 30 April 2020.

Section 4 (t) of Republic Act No. 11469 or the “Bayanihan to Heal As One Act” authorizes alternative working arrangements for employees and workers in the government.

Part of the alternative working arrangements adopted by GSIS are Work from Home (WFH) measures. To effectively implement the said measure, there is a need to provide facilities that would enable communication and collaboration while observing and complying with the quarantine measures. Even when the ECQ is lifted, there is a need to maintain social distancing even within the Head Office and Branch Offices and the Video Conferencing and Online Meeting Software would be an alternative venue for these meeting instead of conducting them face to face.

C.2 BENEFITS

One critical tool that would facilitate the work from home efforts is the use of conference call meetings via web or internet. The proposed solution is needed to enable video conference call meetings, web conferencing, webinars, and screen sharing while ensuring security and confidentiality. There is a need to procure a

subscription service for Video Conferencing and Online Meetings in order to use of software with full collaborative functionalities, strong encryption and end to end security and protection.

D. PROJECT SCOPE

The winning bidder must provide Subscription Services for the Video Conferencing and Online Meeting Software for one (1) year commencing from the issuance of the Purchase Order (PO) or from the date indicated therein, whichever comes later.
