OFFICE ORDER NO. 160-12

SUBJECT: Creation of GSIS National Greening Program Oversight Committee

By virtue of Executive Order (EO) No. 26, dated February 24, 2011, the Office of the President of the Philippines declared and ordered the implementation of the National Greening Program (NGP) as a government priority. The GSIS, as a partner/stakeholder agency shall provide full support and assistance in the planting of at least 131,150 trees by 2016 in coordination with DENR.

The Committee shall:

1. Formulate policies and strategies that will provide support and assistance to the National Greening Program;
2. Monitor and ensure the full participation of employees for the NGP; and
3. Submit a semi-annual report to the GSIS Management Committee, together with its appropriate recommendations.

The functions of the Secretariat shall :

1. Assist the NGP Oversight Committee in the planning and implementation of its activities;
2. Schedule meetings with representatives of DENR and concerned participating agencies;
3. Coordinate matters which require the assistance of DENR and other participating agencies for the NGP;
4. Monitor the compliance by all GSIS employees with activities in line with the NGP; and
5. Submit a compliance report to the GSIS NGP Oversight Committee.

All previous Office Orders are hereby amended, repealed and/or superseded accordingly.

This Office Order shall take effect upon signing and shall remain in full force and effect unless otherwise amended or revoked.
